By constructing a reservoir at our container production site in 2023 we are aiming to raise our usage of recycled water from 34% to 50% within the year.

We also focus on waste reduction, recycling and carbon footprint.

### PLANT HEALTH:

We also lead the way when it comes to innovative developments in plant health, being certified as a Plant Healthy supplier, and contributing to the Plant Health Assurance Scheme.

### PEAT FREE PRODUCTION:

For several years we have been running peat free trials to decrease reliance on peat. We are currently at 60% peat free, working towards 75% peat free production on our container site, and on target to be producing all our plants peat free by 2026.
