
Acer campestre Elegant

This compact Acer campestre was originally cultivated and released from Gelderse Tree Nursery in Opheusden. It was released in 1990 and because of its use in urban locations is becoming a city favourite

As its name 'Huibers Elegant' suggests, this cultivar is a little more slender in the canopy, which will tightly remain within a 4m width throughout its maturity. The ascending branches rise at 45 degrees, creating a lean structure that requires only a modest space

Perfectly selected to bring a little decadence to those compact urban locations. The Elegant will grow in almost all soil types, and handles soil compaction well. Its roots especially tolerate hard pavers in and around their rooting zone.



Its leaves are graceful with lush shades of vibrant green. These are highly resistant to mildew and different species of mites, ensuring their opulent leaves always appear a rich, succulent green in their location. Shortly after, the Samara 'winged achene' seeds appear throughout the early summer that fill the canopy further

A perfect choice where a consistent, uniform appearance is required within urban locations

Its autumn leaves melt into colours of marmalade orange, butter corn yellow, and earthy soft brown.

A reliable choice where canopy and root space is restricted
