
Pinus sylvestris

It is industry known that Wyevale grow the best pine trees in all of Europe. The sylvestris is a staple part of our tree production, with the highest quality always supplied.

This evergreen tree is extremely resilient and will thrive in numerous locations that have difficult conditions. It is a champion for climate change, being a secure choice to thrive within urban areas over the next 40 years.

Its needles are in pairs, with a slight blue green appearance. The renowned bark darkens as it ages, whilst the younger growth of branches and at the top of the trunk having its distinctive shade of marmalade orange.



It is monecious, meaning both male and female. The young female cones are red at pollination, expanding and becoming brown in their second year. The male flowers are a cluster of yellow anthers at the base of the shoots.

A valuable source for wildlife, supporting natural regeneration in any area that it grows. It is an integral part of food webs, and a much needed source of habitat for numerous species when in urban settings. It is a little faster growing than other pine trees, usually losing its lower branches when growing in tighter locations.

When planting for the difficult climate conditions ahead, the Scots pine should always be part of the species specification list.
