
Tilia cordata Select

Our very own Tilia, exclusive to Wyevale and 'Selected' by Chris Mason, our director of tree growing.

This cultivar of the iconic small leaf native lime tree was selected specifically because of its unique improvements for urban applications. This was to ensure the continued success of our native tree planting during difficult climate conditions we see today.

The canopy is a little more ascending than similar cultivars of the species, with a tighter, uniformed appearance. Its glossy, bold green leaves do not suffer with the Aphid honey dew issues, so are always fresh and vibrant in appearance.



The small flowers open in June, and are a magnet for bees, butterflies, and other native pollinators. This provides a valuable control measure to counter act the declining bee population facing the UK today.

Come the autumn, the lush leaves soften in mellow yellow shades of amber.

Perfectly suited for open urban locations where it has room to develop its flowing, consistent canopy. Ideal for planting as a mixed or single species avenue.

A tough, hardy species, with consistent and predictable reliability. This cultivar of the native tree is British grown, and exclusive to Wyevale Nurseries.
