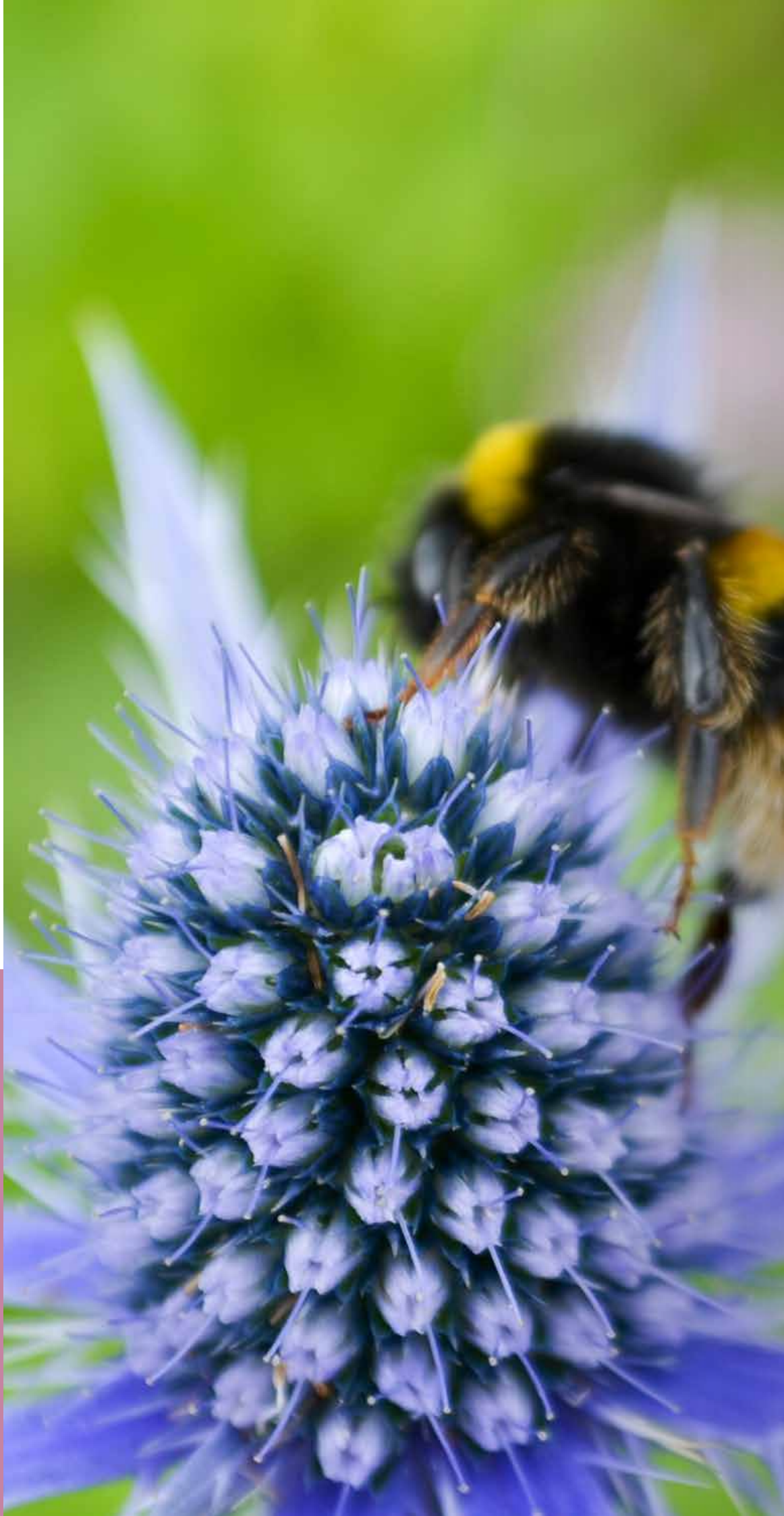

Ajuga Black Scallop is a low-growing mint family plant with sleek and dark foliage. It produces deep blue tubular flowers in spring that attract pollinators. It grows well in partially shaded, well-drained, moist soil and can be used in rock gardens, woodland gardens and borders. The plant is easy to care for, requires minimal maintenance and is drought-tolerant. Its dense foliage can help suppress weed growth and contrasts beautifully with other plants.

Jacobinia pauciflora Firefly

Flowering from late December through to early summer, Firefly provides an eye-catching display for impulse sales. An attractive, compact growing and very rounded evergreen shrub, which is dripping with tubular bicoloured flowers, vivid orange at the base changing to bright yellow at the tip. 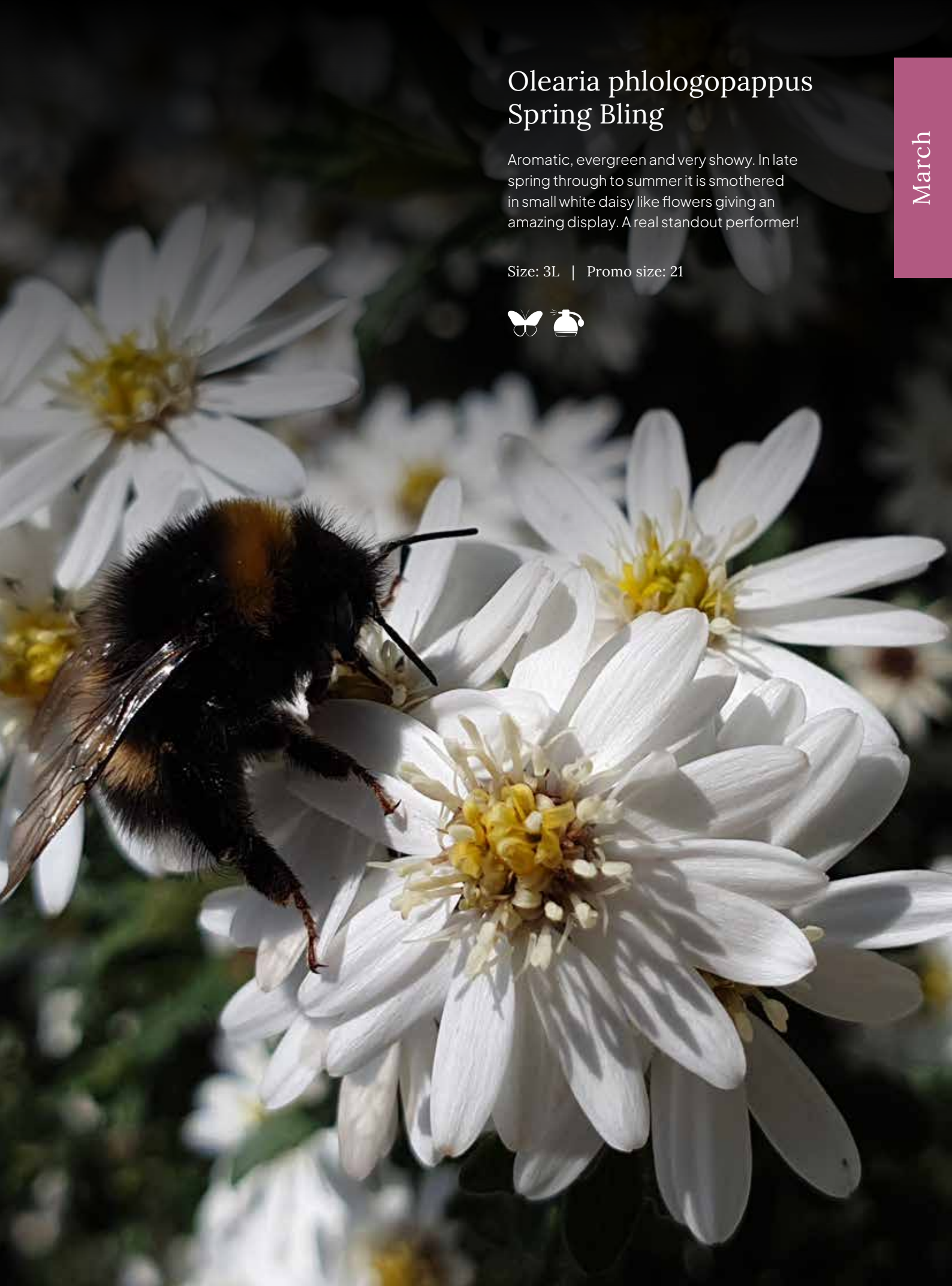

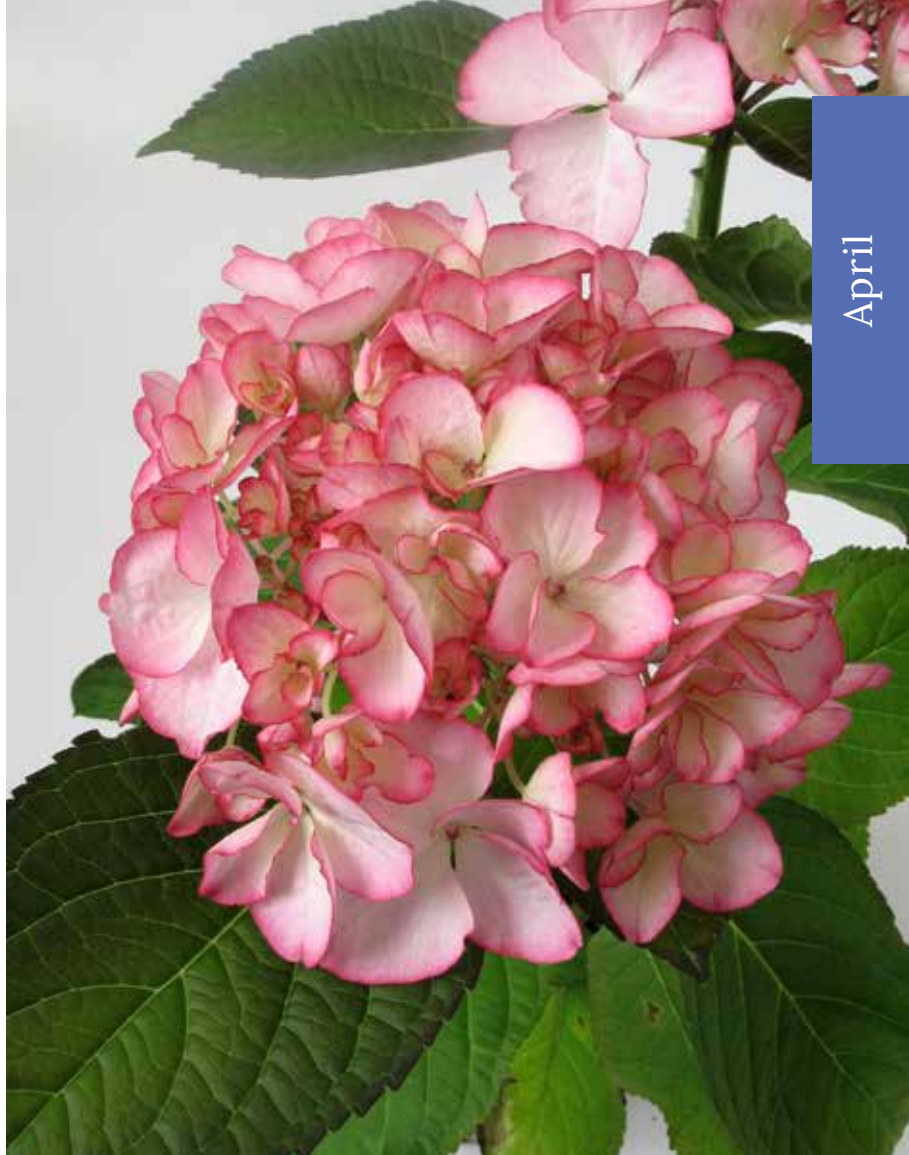

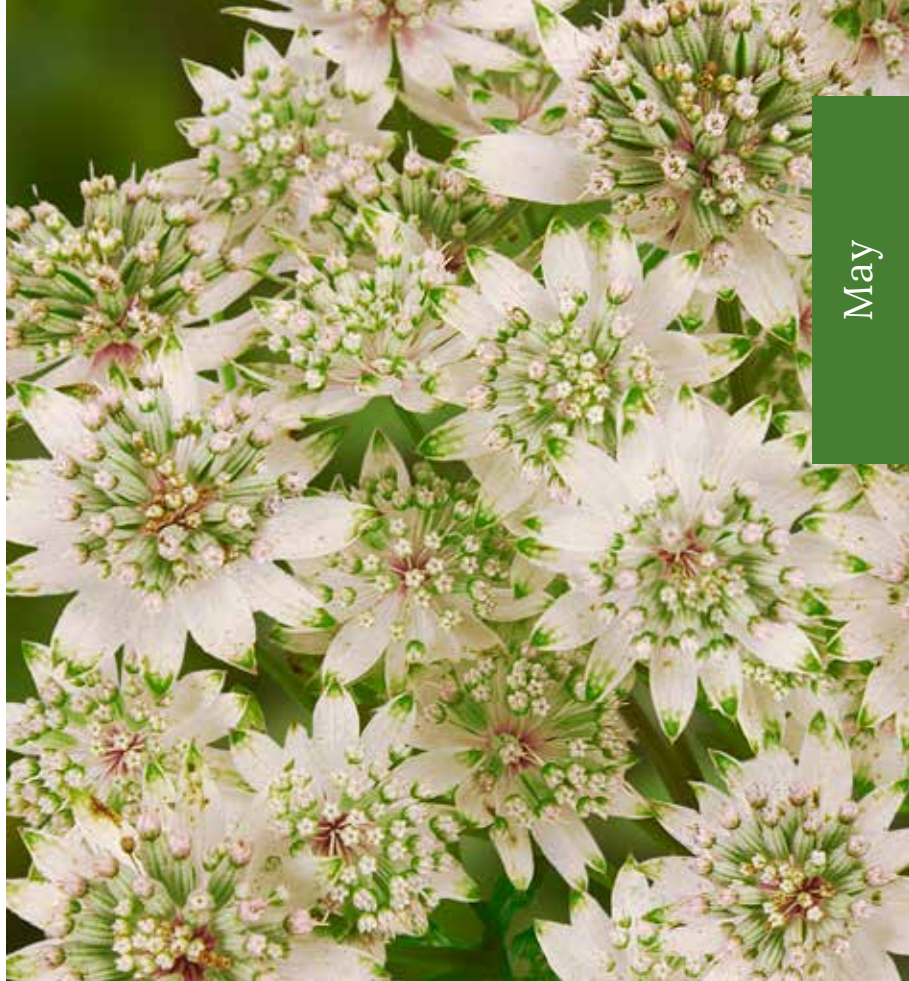
